

"Workplace Awareness - Culture, Gender & Personality"




"Online Language Tools for Self Learning"

REPORT


A one day webinar was organized on "Recent innovation in Biomedical Engineering" by the Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering in association with Institution's Innovation Council on 31st May 2020. Dr.C.Ramkumar, Associate Professor, Department of Biomedical Engineering, Dr.N.G.P College of Technology, Coimbatore was invited as the resource person for this session. The resource person gave a brief introduction that Continuous technological innovations are bringing new opportunities to healthcare applications. Although these improvements apply to most of its different fields, outstanding results are being achieved in medical devices interoperability, oriented to common solutions including wearable devices, focused to the new paradigm of Personal Health. He also said that these evolutions can improve the quality of the patient's care, increase the user's interaction and, furthermore, lead to new medical use cases based on Ambient Assisted Living(AAL), home monitoring of elderly, heart failure, chronic, under palliative care or patients who have undergone surgery, urgencies and emergencies, or even fitness auto-control and health follow-up. Furthermore, in order to assure p-Health applications to be fully compatible with larger global e-Health systems in terms of terminology homogenization or plug-and-play operation, proposed solutions have to be based on interoperability. Finally, he said that recent innovative advances in biomedical engineering are applied to standard-based telemedicine solutions






Figure: 1 Mr.J.Aasaithambi (Founder & Director)/AARON Technologies, has shared his valuable ideas about 'Python Concepts'






Figure: 2 Mr.J.Aasaithambi (Founder & Director) /AARON Technologies, has shared concepts of Python

Differences between program and scripting language

Program

- a program is executed (i.e. the source is first compiled, and the result of that compilation is expected)
- A "program" in general, is a sequence of instructions written so that a computer can perform certain task.

Scripting

- a script is interpreted
 - A "script" is code written in a scripting language. A scripting language is nothing but a type of programming language in which we can write code to control another software application.

- A scripting language or script language is a programming language for a runtime system




Figure: 5 Mr.J.Aasaithambi (Founder & Director) /AARON Technologies, has explained the execution of Python Code.




Figure: 6 Mr.J.Aasaithambi (Founder & Director) /AARON Technologies, has explained the Math Functions.




- Basic concept involved in BIM(Building Information Modeling).










Different forms of Steel structures and steel materials
